After the first two weeks, it’s \$6 per person per week, \$3 for angels (people who already graduated from a class who come to help). John Hyde is our caller/instructor.

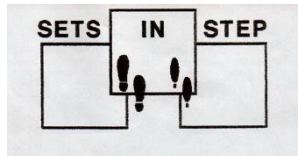
